The Company

Our purpose at Riversimple is to pursue, systematically, the elimination of the environmental impact of personal transport. Everything we do – the design of the vehicle, the structure of the business, the people we work with – is in pursuit of this goal.

We are currently developing lightweight hydrogen fuel cell cars. Riversimple's first vehicle is a neat eco coupe, designed for everyday local journeys. It is agile, responsive and fun to drive. Other model vehicles in the Riversimple development pipeline are a light delivery van and a four door family vehicle.

Rather than selling vehicles, Riversimple is planning to offer vehicles on **subscription** – with a single monthly payment made up of a fixed rate and a mileage rate. The subscription covers the vehicle, its maintenance, insurance and all fuel – in short, every cost associated with running a car. We believe that this will be simpler for customers and definitely better for the environment.

Sustainability and whole system thinking are guiding principles in everything we do and we have taken a clean slate approach to many aspects of business management.

Our headquarters are in the unspoilt rural area of Llandrindod Wells.

Key Objectives of the Role

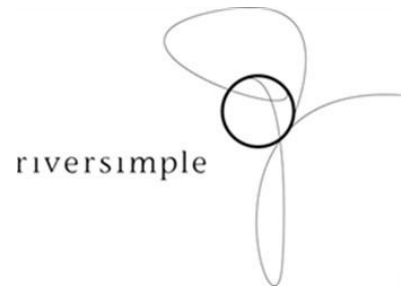
To support the MD and take hands-on responsibility for the everyday smooth financial running of the company, including financial forecasting and cash flow management, and supporting ongoing grant reporting.
