Role: API & Integration developer

Summary: This is a fixed term contract from now until July 2023 as part of the

Circular Revolution project, funded by WEFO.

Working within a small team to develop an API interface to a Hyperledger Fabric application and integrating with existing business systems or scoping and developing proof of concepts for new systems. The team will work with the Computational Foundry of Swansea University as part of a development of Blockchain based tools for Circular Economy businesses.

Based in Llandrindod Wells with some remote working.

Role description:

To design, document, develop, test, release, support and debug code as required; and to take a leading role in maintaining and evolving the full software stack. This includes:

- Collaborating with engineering and business management within Riversimple.
- Working with the Computational Foundry of Swansea
 University to implement an API to the Hyperledger Fabric
 Blockchain application that they are developing under the
 Circular Revolution project.
- Proposing and documenting technical solutions, with estimates of time to delivery.
- Writing and deploying software using, potentially, JavaScript, Python, Go, C++, Docker, JSON, HTML, CSS and Hyperledger Fabric.
- Enforcing quality through thorough peer reviews, and highlighting risks early.
- Writing and helping others write unit tests and manual test scripts.
- Testing software and documenting results.
- Keeping accurate time records for tasks.
- Assisting in solving end users' issues, communicating directly with staff and end users as required.


